1. Introduction

Llandough Primary School is committed to ensuring that all pupils—including those with disabilities—can access all aspects of school life. This Accessibility Plan outlines the school's approach to curriculum access, the physical environment, and accessible communication in line with the Equality Act 2010.

2. The Three Planning Duties

- Increasing access to the curriculum
- Improving access to the physical environment
- Improving delivery of information to disabled pupils and families

3. Audit of Current Provision

- Staff trained in SEN but require further training in assistive technologies.
- Main entrance accessible; some internal doors narrow.
- Standard signage; no induction loop installed.
- Communications mainly in standard print with limited alternative formats.
